Founding Foundation

Türkiye Youth and Education Service Foundation (TÜRKEV), our founder, was established under the guidance of our President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, while he was the Mayor of Istanbul. The foundation, which served in İstanbul under its former name İstanbul Youth and Education Service Foundation (ISEGEV) until 2012, changed its name to Türkiye Youth and Education Service Foundation (TÜRKEV) with a view to expand its service area throughout Türkiye.

Having started to provide services with its two dormitories in İstanbul in 1996, TÜRKEV currently serves our students in 10 provinces, with its 25 student dormitories, 4 Fine Works Factories and 1 children's library as of 2024.

TÜRKEV, which embraced the principle of educating curious, inquisitive, eager to learn, productive and entrepreneurial young people who are well aware of their history, their goals and their own selves, maintains its presence throughout Türkiye, with its more than 5,000 students and more than 40,000 graduates.

TÜRKEV, which set out its journey by establishing higher education dormitories, moved on to expand its scope of service to include secondary education dormitories, Fine Works Factory (GİF) compounds and a children's library. With two locations in İstanbul, one in Ankara and one in Şırnak-Silopi, the Fine Works Factory provides workspaces, cultural activities and educational opportunities for young people. The MevlanaKapı Children's Library and Workshop Center, which enhances the interaction of our dormitories with the neighborhoods where they are located, supports the physical and mental development of children between 0-12.



About Ibn Khaldun

After whom Our University is Named





The well-known historian, sociologist, philosopher, politician, and statesman Ibn Khaldun was born in 1332 and died in 1406. He was well-educated, took lessons from many prominent scholars of the period, spent most of his life in multi-religious, multi-cultural and multi-civilizational societies such as Tunis, Algeria, Morocco, Al-Andalus and Egypt, thanks to his duties in various civil service positions.

Ibn Khaldun has closely observed not only the social orders of the cities that he lived in, but also the nomadic Arab tribes; and he lived as a member of the ruling and intellectual elite of these societies, in his capacity as a social scientist. His authored his renowned work *Muqaddimah* (Introduction) with such extensive accumulation of knowledge, observation and experiment. In fact, *Muqaddimah* consists of only one part of his comprehensive and bulky work, titled “al-‘Ibar”, which serves as a world history volume; namely its first book and introduction.

With his ideas and methods in *Muqaddimah*, which is one of the most original works in the world history of ideas, has deep impacts on the subsequent generations and scholars. It was Ibn Khaldun’s effort to render civilization, which acts within the laws of history and society, and is the result of the human will, subject of a separate field of science. This “umran” science bears considerable potential that could be utilized to understand the inter-civilizational relations in this global age, and to make sense of the modern multi-vilizational social experience.

Our Values

Intellectual Independence: A country that constantly imports its ideas, theories, and methods is intellectually dependent. Intellectual dependence brings along economic, political, and cultural dependencies, and unfortunately, the education system serves the function of instilling these dependencies in the new generations. The most important aspect of intellectual dependence is social sciences. Working towards avoiding being bound by the dominant paradigm in social sciences is the first step towards liberation and originality.

Without achieving intellectual independence, full independence cannot be achieved in any field. Aim of education is to elevate new generations from imitation to analysis, and from copying to present original approaches. Only those individuals who are intellectually independent can move countries and societies towards intellectual independence. Ibn Haldun University, working in this direction, aims to render our country intellectually independent and educate intellectually independent students.

Preparing For The Future: The determining factor of the future will be a highly educated human capital with high capacity, competence, and skill levels. In the context of Türkiye, this human capital will be nurtured by reinterpreting its values in new contexts, drawing strength from universal human knowledge,

and conducting a thorough analysis of change. In this regard, educational institutions that prioritize not only knowledge transfer but also the development of students' skills and competencies through innovative practices will emerge. Ibn Haldun University is taking confident steps towards becoming one of the few established educational institutions with a strong and widespread impact in the future. In line with this, our fundamental mission is to cultivate successful and happy individuals through quality education, generate research projects and publications with high impact value, and thereby contribute to addressing contemporary issues of our time.

Futuwwa: Ibn Haldun University has placed futuwwa at the foundation of its education. Futuwwa, which formed the basis of youth education during the Abbasid, Seljuk, and Ottoman periods in Islamic civilization, is a combination of many values that make a person truly humane, such as courage, heroism, generosity, and self-sacrifice. It is a value system primarily based on manners and etiquette. These values are universal moral virtues, and those who embody futuwwa do not discriminate based on religion, language, race, sect, or denomination. Establishing the characteristic qualities of the "ideal human" presented by our civilization on an individual level, while also striving to manage life by considering both worldly and spiritual balance, is among the essential elements of futuwwa. Ibn Haldun University believes in the adaptation and revitalization of the understanding of fütüvvet, which has manifested the morality of virtuous youth throughout the centuries and guided the youth in the right direction. Therefore, the university continues its educational activities with the conviction that futuwwa should be revived to meet the needs of the present time.

Comparative Education: Comparative education constitutes a unique and distinctive feature of Ibn Haldun University. The method of comparative education will contribute to developing awareness by recognizing and critically examining the scientific,



cultural, and artistic accumulations of world civilizations, starting with the accumulated knowledge of the civilization to which we belong. It will pass through the filter of a critical approach. Thus, one of the essential requirements for intellectual production will be fulfilled. Our educational approach is not limited to teaching social concepts and theories solely from Western sources. It embraces and equally respects the approaches and accumulations of other civilizations. This approach aims to cultivate students who are guided by the ideal of intellectual independence and is among the foundational values of a new social science education at our university.

Multilingual Education: Ibn Haldun University aims to provide its graduates with the ability to utilize the scientific traditions, methods, and concepts related to Eastern and Western civilizations within the framework of its global objectives, its mission as a research university focused on social sciences, and its principle of intellectual independence. In this regard, it is of great importance for our students to develop skills in thinking and expressing themselves in different languages and to have easier access to primary sources in different languages. With internationally accredited language education programs, our university not only teaches languages but also provides opportunities for students to delve into the cultural and social issues that arise within those language environments, thanks to its international teaching staff.

Tradition-Based Innovation: Ibn Haldun University implements a new social science education that aims to cultivate students according to the ideal of intellectual independence. These education programs are conducted with the approach of "Tradition-Based Innovation." In a society where imitation prevails in the name of innovation, a renewal that is free from imitation and distortion, and intellectual independence and originality in ideas and arts can only be achieved through the approach of traditional innovation.

The approach of "tradition-based innovation," representing moderation and balance, will manifest itself in the reconstruction of our ancient heritage in harmony with tradition and contemporary developments.

Open Civilization: Open Civilization is a civilization concept that recognizes the existence and right to life of other civilizations and advocates for universal human rights. Introducing the concept of Open Civilization and its historical applications to the world, establishing a consciousness of civilization by redefining our own concept and theory of civilization as the first step, followed by developing global literacy regarding the accumulations of the world's leading civilizations, forms the basis of our educational activities.






Ibn Haldun University Complex

The Ibn Haldun University Complex has been modelled on the classical Turkish architecture in Başakşehir and put into service in 2020. With its modern faculty buildings, classrooms, congress halls, studio, amphitheater, Student Center, Sports Center, comfortable dormitories, library, and “accessible university” and “green campus” practices, social facilities and living spaces, IHU became a complete “campus university”. Ibn Haldun University Complex, with its 190,000 square meter open space and 80,000 square meter closed space, meets all the needs of students and academic staff both in curricular and extracurricular activities.





Süleymaniye Campus


The historical madrasahs that have been standing for 450 years in the Süleymaniye Complex, constructed by Sinan the Architect upon the request of Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent, and served as an educational institution for centuries, have been revitalized by Ibn Haldun University, serving as the stage for its many scholarly activities, in a location that defines the silhouette of İstanbul, "city of seven hills". Located in the Süleymaniye Complex, which was inaugurated on October 3, 2018, the Mülazimler Madrasah, Darulhadis, Darulkurra, Salis Madrasah, and İmaret buildings are now home to some programs of the University's Alliance of Civilizations Institute and School of Islamic Studies.

Located on our Süleymaniye Campus, the Darüşşifa is one of the historical madrasahs allocated to our University. It now serves under the umbrella of our University's Psychotherapy Application and Research Center (IPAM).


In addition to housing clinical laboratories and psychotherapy service areas, the Darüşşifa functions as an incubation center for original research and studies on Islam and Psychology, serving both our civilization and the scientific world. The Darüşşifa will also host activities geared towards international projects and collaborations in the field of Clinical Psychology.

The Süleymaniye Darüşşifası, part of the Süleymaniye Complex, was built in 1577 and served as an active healthcare center for 296 years. The Darüşşifa also functioned as a hospital where students receiving theoretical education at the Medical Madrasah applied their medical knowledge practically to patients. In this sense, the Darüşşifa continues to fulfill its historical mission within the body of Ibn Haldun University.



Süleymaniye Campus Historical Unkapanı Mill Facilities






Süleymaniye Campus Historical Unkapanı Mill Facilities

The project of reviving the Historical Unkapanı Mill, one of the most important industrial cultural heritage items of Istanbul, as the Süleymaniye Campus of our University was launched on March 28, 2024. Within the framework of this restoration project, located in the center of the city, in which the existing historical texture will also be preserved; our University will have a living, developing and producing modern facility that will serve both our university members and non-University participants, with activities in various fields such as graduate education, public education programs, incubation centers for qualified project designs and foreign language education, in an area of 13,000 square meters that includes the historical Unkapanı Mill.





Taş Mektep Campus

Taş Mektep, located in the central point of Bakırköy, was built in 1874, has been restored and allocated to Ibn Haldun University. This historical building serves as the campus of our university in Bakırköy, hosting our Public Certified Training Programs at the Continuing Education Center (İHSEM), which is open to the public.








Sports Center

Within the scope of the Sports Center, a 215-seat indoor basketball court, indoor football field, indoor swimming pool, indoor tennis court, wrestling hall, fitness rooms, archery range, squash courts, sauna, steam room, and salt room, as well as open football, basketball, volleyball and tennis courts.

Distinguished from others, the Sports Center offers our members and people of the district an exclusive and enjoyable sporting experience with its archery range, squash courts, sauna, steam room, and salt room. Additionally, it provides a green and serene environment with a surrounding landscape area of 12,000 m², where people can relax and engage in various activities. The Sports Center is equipped with amenities such as warming and changing rooms, a vitamin bar, a café, a masjid, and a first aid room, ensuring that every detail is meticulously planned and implemented.

Green Campus

Ibn Haldun University Complex, which has a green area of 125,000 square meters, is one of the distinguished universities of our country, with its 74 square meters of green space per student. Ibn Haldun University Complex has exceptionally beautiful trees such as holm oak, magnolia, olive, sweetgum and birch trees; and it features a fruit garden with 124 fruit trees. Furthermore, there are 44 hobby gardens in the valley called Ibn Haldun Grove, located within the Complex, and they are periodically allocated to all our members, particularly our students.

The bicycle path in our Complex, extending from the dormitories area to the schools area, is integrated to the bicycle path of Başakşehir Municipality, which is the longest one in Türkiye, and there are around 100 bicycle parks in the Complex.

Furthermore, PV panels installed on the roofs of buildings in the Ibn Haldun University Complex have been activated, thereby providing a renewable and zero-emission energy source for the University.


Activities aiming at increasing the environmental sensitivities of the members of our University, and to raise awareness are carried out.



Recreation and Study Areas






Culture-Art-Sports at IHU



According to reports published by Ibn Haldun University, the Council of Higher Education (YÖK), and other prestigious institutions, our university ranks among the top universities with the highest international student density in Türkiye. The ratio of our international students to the total number of students is approximately over 30 percent. 

A Genuine “Foundation” University

At Ibn Haldun University, it is of utmost importance that our students are free from material concerns, and are focused on their education and academic development. At our University where most of 80% of our students continue their education under full exemption from tuition fees (full scholarship), we also provide a wide spectrum of in cash scholarship supports and assist our students in many other areas.

Multilingualism in Graduate Studies Policy

Ibn Haldun University considers reaching a certain level of proficiency in English, Turkish, and Arabic (or another language, excluding thesis-based Turkish programs and non-thesis programs) as a graduation requirement in its graduate programs. Students can fulfill the language graduation requirements either by receiving education in the Preparatory Program before their program or by successfully completing language courses during their program. Students who can demonstrate proficiency at the required level in these languages through exam results accepted by the University also fulfill the graduation obligation. The language proficiency level is determined by the Program Coordination.

A Social Sciences-Focused University

Ibn Haldun University is entirely focused on social sciences. In this framework, undergraduate education activities continue in Guidance and Psychological Counseling program under School of Education; Law program under School of Law, New Media and Communication under School of Communication; Islamic Sciences program under School of Islamic Sciences; Philosophy, Comparative Literature, Psychology, Political Science and International Relations, Sociology, and History programs under School of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Economics and Management programs under School of Business. At our University, where graduate studies are offered through our Institute of Graduate Studies and Institute of Alliance of Civilizations; we offer Ph.D. degrees in Psychology and Clinical Psychology; Ph.D. and Master's degrees in Philosophy, Economics, Management, Civilization Studies, Private Law, Political Science and International Relations, Sociology, History, Islamic Sciences and New Media and Communication programs; and master's degrees in Big Data and Business Analytics, Religious Sciences, Managing Educational Institutions, Artificial Intelligence Technologies in Education, Philosophical, Social and Historical Fundamentals of Education, Philosophy, Financial Economy, Air Transport Management, Public Law, Middle East Studies, Radio, Television and Cinema, Guidance and Psychological Counseling, Turkish Studies, and International and Comparative Law.

With more than 50% of the student population consisting of master's and Ph.D. students, our university places significant emphasis on research methods and techniques, at the undergraduate and graduate levels, as an integral part of education and training processes.

A Trademark in Language Education: IHU School of Languages

The School of Languages at Ibn Haldun University is one of the leading language schools in Türkiye, offering internationally accredited language education. Our university provides instruction in three languages: Turkish, English, and Arabic. In addition to these three languages, students have the opportunity to learn optional Eastern languages such as Japanese, Chinese, Persian, and Malay, which open the door to the accumulated knowledge of world civilizations, as well as Western languages such as German, French, and Spanish.

In the English Language Program, students receive world-class English education using the latest technological and pedagogical methods, taught by native English-speaking instructors. The Arabic Language Program uses modern methods to teach Arabic to non-native speakers, taking into account the rich heritage and tradition of the Arabic language while incorporating innovative approaches. The Turkish Language Program aims to provide participants with the necessary Turkish language skills for their daily lives and academic pursuits by combining theoretical and practical education.

Furthermore, the Language School plays a crucial role in enhancing the language learning skills of Türkiye's youth at all levels by offering certified training for foreign language teachers through "educator training" programs in collaboration with international institutions at the Teacher Academy.

At Ibn Haldun University, both preparatory classes and other language courses are conducted in small classes of 10-15 students, creating a personalized and intensive learning environment.



It has a collection of over 550 million reliable resources, consisting of printed and electronic works.

The inspirational study areas of the library and its innovative services assist users in attaining their academic goals. It has a rich and distinguished collection, consisting of Turkish, English and Arabic works. They include books in various types, primary sources and reference sources.

The Library obtains the resources that are not listed in the collections but its users need, through subscriptions, purchasing, donations, and borrowing from other libraries, in a timely manner, and with the best possible means of access. It utilizes the collections of all universities and research libraries in Türkiye, through agreements made with them, and makes available its own collections to researchers who need them. Beside the standard library services, it supports researchers through regular training on research methods and techniques, academic profiling and reference management systems.

Library services are available 24/7 at its three-storey stand-alone building at the entrance of the campus, and it possesses 2,488 square meter closed space, and 2,824 meter shelf length.



Philosophy and Artificial Intelligence (English)

The Philosophy and Artificial Intelligence undergraduate program aims to train students as the “philosopher-AI specialists” that the age requires, equipping them with both technical and conceptual skills. The curriculum offers core philosophical fields such as ethics, epistemology, and philosophy of mind together with technical subjects including artificial intelligence, machine learning, natural language processing, and data analysis, presented through an integrated approach. As the impact of AI on individuals, societies, and ethical values grows, this program seeks to combine philosophical reflection with technological development to produce human- and civilization-centered solutions. Graduates will be uniquely positioned to contribute to emerging fields such as cognitive science, AI ethics, philosophy of mind, and technology policy. The program also provides opportunities for deep specialization in both philosophy and computer science.

Law (30% English)

The School of Law at Ibn Haldun University employs interactive and comparative teaching methods, incorporating both traditional and innovative approaches, as well as utilizing the opportunities provided by technology. The School fosters an education approach that encourages active student participation with a small number of students, introduces them to primary sources prior to class, promotes critical thinking, and instills a research-oriented mindset during undergraduate education. Furthermore, practical courses are offered beside theoretical ones; legal clinics and mediation clinics are established and participation in national and international moot court competitions are ensured to enhance their practical skills.

Economics (English)

Comparative Literature (English)

The vision of the Department of Comparative Literature is to generate knowledge and create awareness about the fluidity of civilizations by comparing works written in European and Middle Eastern languages, and Turkish literature. The Department of Comparative Literature not only allows us to gain knowledge about different cultures but also equips students with comparative evaluation skills, enabling them to apply this interdisciplinary and comparative approach to different fields. Based on a critical perspective, the Department aims to closely follow developments in literature, language, culture, and cinema, and to educate scholars who will contribute to discussions in these areas.

Big Data and Business Analytics (In Turkish)

The Master's Degree Programs in Big Data and Business Analytics aims to provide general knowledge and skills on how to process big data in a manner that enables optimal decision-making, increases productivity, and reduces costs, and to teach fundamental concepts and tools used in data analytics. The students also acquire skills to effectively use data analytics technology and decision support systems effectively to address real-world problems encountered in the business environment, and graduate after developing a unique skill set that are in high demand in today's data-driven business world.

Religious Studies (30% English)

The Religious Studies Master's Program aims to focus on the history, social and psychological dimensions of religion, to carry out current studies in its field and to train students in this direction. The Master's Degree Program in the Philosophical, Social, and Historical Fundamentals of Education strives to establish a new ground for research with educational experts who can examine the historical, philosophical, and social foundations of national and international educational systems and evaluate contemporary educational perspectives. On the strong interdisciplinary ground that it provides, the program educates graduates who can approach the fundamental issues of education with a philosophical, social and historical perspective, with a sophisticated interpretative, normative and critical thinking on education, and who can contribute to the formation of the educational thinking of the society that they are living in, in line with the universal values and future trends.

Philosophy (English)

Ph.D. and Master's Program in Philosophy takes a non-Eurocentric approach by examining both Western and Islamic philosophy in their historical contexts and interactions, aiming to provide students with a universal perspective. The program offers a pluralistic curriculum that draws from traditions of Western philosophy based on Ancient, Islamic, Turkish, and Western philosophy, and brings together the theories and perspectives that emerged in the history of philosophy, in consideration of the classical and modern discussions. With the multi-faceted formation it offers, the main objective of the program is to train academics who can study the tradition of Islamic philosophy not only as a historical phenomenon but also within the context of contemporary philosophy, providing a versatile formation.

Financial Economics (English)

One distinctive feature of the programs is that students have the opportunity to learn different economic theories together, enabling them to develop the competence to generate alternative solutions to contemporary economic and social problems. Besides, the students are offered the opportunity to analyze the economy as a whole, and to train themselves as internationally active, respected economists, with high analytical skills and wide perspective.

Islamic Economics and Finance (English)

The Master's Degree Programme in Islamic Economics and Finance has been designed for individuals who wish to specialise in the growing field of Islamic finance, taking into account the transformations in both our country's and the global financial system. Thanks to its strategic location and deep ties with the Islamic world, Turkey has the potential to rapidly become a centre for Islamic finance. Ibn Haldun University aims to reinforce this potential through academic education, providing its students with both theoretical knowledge and practical skills. The programme will teach students how to manage the global financial system in a more equitable, sustainable, and ethical manner, while also comprehensively covering the fundamental principles of Islamic finance, such as equitable distribution, risk sharing, and the prohibition of interest.

Management (English)

Public Law (Turkish)

Clinical Psychology (30% English)

The Clinical Psychology Ph.D. and Master's Programs provide research, development and implementation opportunities along with a solid theoretical foundation. The program offers not only a comparative and multilingual theoretical education that is enriched with different psychotherapy approaches, but also an intensive practical experience to the students through the internship programs and clinical training at the Psychotherapy Application and Research Center. The program also provides the opportunity for students to obtain assistantship and lecturing experience. Two research laboratories in the program support the academic development of students through encouraging them to participate in research projects, make scientific publications and other academic activities.


Psychology (English)

Radio, Television and Cinema (Turkish)



New Media and Communication (English)


