

The SQ2R Method

SURVEY



Carefully pre-read the chapter. Look at the title, subtitles, graphs/diagrams, summary/conclusion and end-of-chapter questions to get a picture view of the reading.



QUESTION

Inquiry makes you an active reader. Formulate questions such as "What is this article about?" before you read. Convert titles, subtitles, etc. into questions.

READ & ANNOTATE



Translate key ideas and new terms into your own words. Research any answers or information which do not seem clear enough.



REVIEW

Reread your notes as often as possible. Frequent review enables you to better keep the material.
