1. Up to 65% discount is applied for corporate agreements. If there are 10 or more participants from the institution, 70% discount is applied.

2. International agencies may be authorised to offer discounts of 25%, 50% and up to 70% for students coming through them.

3. In graduate programmes, 5% of that year's non-discounted programme fee of the relevant programme is requested from all scholarship/fee-paid students who exceed the normal education period and who will complete their thesis within the maximum period or who come with a lateral transfer and whose courses are accepted and who will only take a thesis, for each semester they will renew their registration.

4. The discount received by the student for the programme fee is also valid for the language preparation and scientific preparation programmes, unless there is a separate decision taken by the Graduate School Administrative Board for the student.5. In the scientific preparation programme, if the student is exempted from some courses in the programme, 5% of the programme fee per course is requested for the other courses he/she needs to take.

DECISION 4- Based on the letter dated 14.03.2023 and numbered 24233 of the Directorate of the Graduate School of Graduate Education of our university, it was unanimously decided by the participants of the meeting to accept the request to translate the language of education of the Department of Radio, Television and Cinema 30% English Radio, Television and Cinema Master's Programmes with and without Thesis into 100% Turkish based on the reasons stated below and to notify the Presidency of the Council of Higher Education.

- It is thought that the phenomenon that humanity has accepted and assimilated most seriously within the global-scale digital transformation is "digitalisation in communication". Following the introduction of numerous digital tools in mass communication and interpersonal communication and the integration of traditional communication tools into digital, almost all social, economic and cultural areas of life have entered into a comprehensive digital transformation.
- It is not yet possible to say that all of the organisations operating in the fields of radio, television and cinema, which are known as the most established traditional mass media, have taken all the necessary steps to appeal to the digital society. It is seen that some of the media professionals in our country are turning towards postgraduate education in order to develop innovative activities in this field and to examine and discuss qualified international examples.
- Especially considering the people working in the media sector, it is seen that the level of English foreign language is not sufficient for every master's degree candidate. For this reason, there is a need for programmes that will provide 100% Turkish education in order to maximise the efficiency.

- It is aimed that Radio, Television and Cinema master's programmes with and without thesis, which will provide 100% Turkish education, will contribute to the digital content production skills of media professionals and accelerate the digital transformation of media institutions in our country with original studies and application studies.
- Although there are currently New Media and Communication Master's and PhD programmes in the field of communication within our university, there is no programme that provides education entirely in Turkish. It is thought that by changing the language of instruction of Radio, Television and Cinema master's programmes with and without thesis to 100% Turkish, this deficiency will be overcome, as well as the difficulties experienced between students from Turkey and international students in terms of the language of instruction will be overcome with programmes that provide bilingual education in Turkish and English, such as our 30% English Radio, Television and Cinema programme.

DECISION 7- It was unanimously decided by the participants of the meeting to accept the tuition fees and cash scholarship fees of the current undergraduate programme students continuing at our university as of the 2023-2024 academic year as stated below and to submit them to the Board of Trustees.

- To increase the tuition fees of students enrolled with YKS by decreasing the annual CPI rate for August 2023 by 10%.
- b. No increase for international students enrolled in undergraduate programmes,

DECISION 8- In accordance with Article 4, paragraph 4 of the Undergraduate Scholarship Directive of our University, it was unanimously decided by the participants of the meeting to accept the scope of Preference Scholarship, Degree Scholarship and Prestige Scholarship to be valid for students who will enrol in our University as of the 2023-2024 Academic Year as stated below and to submit them to the Board of Trustees.

a. Within the scope of the preference scholarship; a monthly cash payment of 2,500 TL is made to scholarship students who write the programmes of the University in their first preference or in all of their first three preferences and are placed.

b. Within the scope of the degree scholarship; Among the scholarship students who are placed in the university, those who have the following rankings in Turkey with YKS scores are paid monthly cash payments in the amounts of 6,000 TL, 5,500 TL and 5,000 TL respectively.

i. Top 10,000, top 20,000 and top 30,000 for Guidance and Psychological Counselling and Sociology Undergraduate Programmes,

ii. Top 10,000, top 10,000-20,000 and top 20,000-30,000 for Political Science and International Relations, Economics, Business Administration Undergraduate Programmes,

iii. Top 2,500, top 2,500-5,000 and top 5,000-7,500 for Law and Psychology Undergraduate Programmes,

iv. Top 1,000, top 1,000-2,000 and top 2,000-3,000 for New Media and Communication Undergraduate Programme,

v. Top 1,000, top 1,000-2,000 and top 2,000-3,000 for the Islamic Sciences Undergraduate Programme,

vi. Top 500, top 500-1,000 and top 1,000-2,000 for the History Undergraduate Programme.

c. Within the scope of prestige scholarship; 7,500TL monthly cash payment is made to the top 50 in Verbal score type and top 100 in Equal Weight score type among the students who are placed in the university.
