**DECISION 2-** The findings obtained during the Higher Education Quality Council Field Visit Report and Quality Studies were discussed. As a result of the discussions; It was unanimously decided by the participants of the meeting to prepare and follow the following processes in order to take measures within the PDCA cycle and to increase the quality of our University's education and training processes.

In order to ensure the continuous development of the education and training processes of the programmes, internal and external stakeholder opinions are taken and the examples that have become prominent are examined and the following issues are examined and the necessary improvements are made, the Heads of Departments submit them to the Dean's Office until 05 April 2024, and the Deans submit them to the Rector's Office until 12 April 2024 by providing the necessary controls;

- 1. Programme Outcomes
- 2. Eight half-year lesson plans
- 3. Course Outcomes
- 4. Matching course outcomes with programme outcomes
- 5. Matching programme outcomes with TQF
- 6. ECTS credits of courses

- 7. Syllabus of the courses
- 8. Compliance of the teaching-learning methods of the courses with the course outcomes
- 9. The appropriateness of the assessment and evaluation methods of the courses to the course outcomes
- 10. Matching the sub-questions and stages, if any, of the assignments, projects, etc. given in the courses with the course outcomes and attaching the document with this matching to the exam envelope when submitting the exam papers,
- 11. Adding an answer key and/or scoring key and/or rubric to the exam envelopes, based on the scoring appropriate to the type of exam,
- 12. In order to ensure accountability before the exam envelopes are delivered, copies of a sample with high scores, medium scores and low scores for each exam are taken and archived separately for quality studies by hiding student personal information,
- 13. Planning actions for improvements that can be made in courses by taking into account student course satisfaction surveys
- 14. Planning actions for improvements that can be made in courses by taking into account student programme competency surveys
- 15. Determining the professional development trainings for the realisation of the actions determined based on the results of the student surveys and those who will participate in these trainings and requesting them in writing from the Centre for Innovative Teaching and Learning with Artificial Intelligence
- 16. The Centre for Innovative Teaching and Learning with Artificial Intelligence to create a training of trainers plan and calendar to cover the trainings specified in these requests and other trainings determined to achieve the mission and vision of our University, and to share it with all shareholder via website and e-mail.
