DECISION 8- The proposed fees for courses to be offered in the Summer School of our university for the 2023–2024 academic year are submitted to the Board of Trustees as outlined below,

a) Fees for courses to be offered in the Summer term of the 2023-2024 Academic Year:

- Students of Ibn Haldun University:

Language courses: 140 hours: 1*.*** TL (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian)

Language courses: 70 hours: 8.*** TL

Department courses: Single course (42 hours): 8.*** TL

Turkish & English Preparatory Summer School: 7.*** TL

- Turkish citizens and international students studying in Turkey outside Ibn Haldun University:

Language courses: 140 hours: 2*.*** TL

Department courses: Single course (42 hours): 1*.*** TL

- Turkish citizens and international students studying abroad:

Language courses: 140 hours (in-person): 3*** USD (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian)

Language courses: 140 hours (online): 2*** USD (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian)
(minimum 2 students)

Department courses: Single course (42 hours) (in-person): 5** USD

Department courses: Single course (42 hours) (online): 4** USD

b) For Turkish citizens and international students studying abroad, a discount of 2** USD (140 hours) / 5* USD (42 hours) will be applied if students submit a recommendation letter,

c) Turkish citizens and international students studying abroad may choose between in-person and online education,

d) Free courses will be offered during the summer for Turkish and Arabic language classes for students enrolled in the Graduate School of Education and undergraduate programs,

e) Students of the Faculty of Islamic Sciences may register free of charge for pedagogical formation courses offered in the Summer School,

This decision was made unanimously by the attendees.

DECISION 9- In accordance with Article 4, Clause 4 of our university's Undergraduate Scholarship Directive, it was unanimously decided by the attendees to present the following scholarship types for students enrolling in our university starting from the 2024-2025 academic year to the Board of Trustees:

a. Preference Scholarship; Students who write the university's programs as their first choice or all of their top three choices and are placed will receive a monthly preference scholarship of 7.*** TL.

b. Merit Scholarship; Among the scholarship students who enroll in the university, those with YKS scores ranking as specified below will receive monthly cash payments of 1*.*** TL, 1*.*** TL, and 8.*** TL, respectively:

- **For the verbal score type:** Islamic Studies, History, New Media and Communication Programs for the top 500, top 1,000, and top 2,000.
- **For the equal weight score type:** Law, Economics, Business Administration, Psychology, Guidance and Psychological Counseling, Political Science and International Relations, and Sociology Undergraduate Programs for the top 2,500, top 5,000, and top 10,000.

c. Prestige Scholarship; Students who enroll in the university and rank in the top 100 for the verbal score type and in the top 250 for the equal weight score type will receive a monthly cash payment of 1*.*** TL

DECISION 10- It was unanimously decided by the attendees to present the tuition fees for the 2024-2025 academic year for our university's undergraduate programs for YKS and international students, as specified in the table below, to the Board of Trustees.
