RESOLUTION 2- The “T Score System,” which was previously discussed at the Senate meeting dated 09.05.2025 and numbered 2025/06, was reconsidered. Following the deliberations, it was unanimously resolved by the attendees of the meeting to approve the proposal to use the formula of the objective evaluation score, referred to as the “T Score Calculation System” and provided below, for the evaluation of **applications such as non-academic international program applications and similar extracurricular activities**, which are based on the overall grade point average (GPA) used as a criterion in assessing academic performance of students enrolled in **different undergraduate programs** of our University; and to stipulate that the T Score shall not have any validity outside the scope of the aforementioned evaluations.

T Score Calculation

$$Z = (X - \mu) / \sigma$$

X: The individual GPA of the student (for example, Ayşe's GPA is 3.2).

μ: The average GPA of all students in the student's department (for example, the Faculty of Law's average GPA is 3.0).

σ: The standard deviation of GPAs in the student's department (for example, the standard deviation in the Faculty of Law is 0.4).

The above calculation demonstrates how the "Z Score" is computed in statistics. By nature, this score ranges between -3 and 3. For easier management and better presentation, it is converted into a "T Score."

The T Score is calculated using the formula:

$$\text{T SCORE} = (\text{Z SCORE}) \times 10 + 50.$$

RESOLUTION 3- It was unanimously resolved by the attendees of the meeting to present the tuition fees to be applied for the courses offered in the 2024–2025 Summer School term to the Board of Trustees, as specified below.

a) Tuition fees to be applied for the courses to be offered at Ibn Haldun University during the Summer term of the 2024–2025 academic year:

-Students of Ibn Haldun University:

Language courses: 140 hours: 1*.*** TRY (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian) (to be opened with a minimum of 7 students)

Language courses: 70 hours: 1*.*** TRY (to be opened with a minimum of 5 students)

Department courses: Single course (42 hours): 1*.*** TRY (to be opened with a minimum of 4 students)

Turkish citizens and international students studying outside Ibn Haldun University in Turkey:

Language courses: 140 hours: 2*.*** TRY (to be opened with a minimum of 5 students)

Department courses: Single course (42 hours): 1*.*** TRY (to be opened with a minimum of 3 students)

-Turkish citizens and international students studying abroad:

Language courses: 140 hours (in-person): 3*** USD (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian) (minimum of 2 students required)

Language courses: 140 hours (online): 2*** USD (Turkish, Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, Persian) (minimum of 2 students required)

Department courses: Single course (42 hours) (in-person): 5** USD (minimum of 3 students required)

Department courses: Single course (42 hours) (online): 4** USD (minimum of 3 students required)

- b) That students who are Turkish citizens or international students studying abroad shall be granted a discount of 2* USD (for 140-hour courses) / 5* USD (for 42-hour courses) upon submission of a letter of recommendation,**
- c) That students in this category shall be allowed to choose between in-person and online instruction,**
- d) That, within the scope of multilingualism, language courses in Arabic and Turkish required by the curriculum may be offered during the summer term for graduate students of the Graduate School.**
