RESOLUTIONS

RESOLUTION 1- Pursuant to the letter dated March 11, 2026, No. 70397, from the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Management Sciences at our university; A**** K*****Y, a student in the Economics Bachelor's Program (student ID 2*****3), who is eligible to graduate at the end of the spring semester of the 2025–2026 academic year and wishes to take ECON 435, it was decided by unanimous vote of the meeting attendees to approve A**** K*****Y, student number 2*****3 in the Economics Bachelor's Program, to take the course ECON 435 Forecasting in Financial Markets—which falls under the ECON DE5 field in his curriculum—in addition to the 42 ECTS credits.

1. Agencies that recruit international students may be authorized to offer a discount of up to 7*% for students who enroll through them.		
2a. For students who have their courses transferred or who enter through lateral transfer, 1*% of the current program fee is charged for each course, proficiency requirement, and thesis. After the amount due is calculated, any applicable discounts are applied.		
2b. In master's programs requiring a thesis, the thesis is counted as two semesters; in doctoral and integrated doctoral programs, it is counted as four semesters.		
2c. Clause 2b does not apply to internal lateral transfers.		
2d. For all scholarship or fee-paying students in graduate programs who exceed the standard duration of study but will complete their thesis within the maximum allowed time, or who have transferred laterally and had their courses accepted and will only be taking thesis work, a fee of 1*,*** TL for Turkish citizens and 7** \$ for international students will be charged for each semester they renew their registration.		
3. In the scientific preparatory program, 10% of the program fee is charged per course. Once the amount due has been calculated, any applicable discounts are applied.		
4. Students who are employed as administrative staff or research assistants at Ibn Haldun University and are simultaneously enrolled in a graduate program are not required to pay a thesis fee within the maximum allowed timeframe.
