- ★ Potential updates to the application calendar will be shared at https://international.ihu.edu.tr/erasmus-and-exchange/ and Instagram account (www.instagram.com/ihu.international/). It is highly recommended that our students follow our announcements regularly.
- ★ Applicants for study mobility will be candidates for the Fall or Spring semester of 2025-2026 academic year. Applicants will choose the preferred semester through the application TURNA PORTAL. All activities must terminate before 30.07,2026.
- ★ Preferred semester cannot be changed after the application, except in cases of force majeure. Please note that visa rejection or lack of a visa appointment does not count as force majeure.
- ★ In order to avoid delays after the announcement of results, the coordinator and students should carefully follow the application deadlines of the host institution.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- 1. Being an active student in IHU.
- 2. A student can benefit from the Erasmus+ KA-171 International Credit Mobility Program for a maximum of 1 semester. Students are not allowed to extend their mobility as part of the KA-171 project rules.
- 3. Academic GPA of at least 2.50/4.00 for undergraduate students, and at least 3.00/4.00 for graduate students. Your transcript can be issued through e-devlet.





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Please make sure that your transcript is issued with dates after the start of application, i.e. 1 November 2024. **Transcripts without a valid date of issue or issued before 1 November 2024** will not be accepted and **the application will be considered invalid.**

- 4. A minimum English exam score from one of these exams must be obtained:
 - IHU Erasmus English Exam (70/100)
 - YÖKDİL/e-YÖKDİL/YDS/e-YDS (70/100)
 - TOEFL (84/100)
 - * IHU Erasmus English Exam is different from what students take for English prep-school (i.e. Versant Exam). Students cannot apply to Erasmus with their prep-school exam scores.
 - * The relevant exam results are **valid for two years** from the date of receipt. Students who want to apply with the previous IHU Erasmus English Exam have to mark this option during the application phase on TURNA PORTAL. **Only one** exam result will be taken into account. If you mark two options during the application, your application will be considered invalid.
- 5. The following students **cannot apply**:
 - Students who are in Language Preparatory year
 - Students who are in their first semester of undergraduate or graduate program in Ibn Haldun University (IHU) and has no GPA during the application period from the courses registered in IHU
 - Students who came with a transfer from another institution and are in the first semester of their registration in IHU (i.e. a transfer student who has not yet received a GPA from courses taken in IHU during the application period)
 - PhD students who have not taken the doctoral qualification exam, and are in the last period of taking the exam (check the <u>Regulation on Graduate Studies</u>)
 - PhD students who are in the last period of their thesis proposal defense
 - PhD students who are in the last period of the maximum duration of the program
- 6. Masters or PhD students who are currently in the 4th semester of their program and have not yet taken a seminar course and have not completed the program course load must submit a permission petition from their thesis and/or academic advisor within the application period (check the draft version of the petition, attached to the announcement email).





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7. Students who have transferred from another program within IHU, can apply with their current GPA.

WHERE TO APPLY?

Applications must be made through TURNA PORTAL. Application link; https://turnaportal.ua.gov.tr

* Applications will start on November 1, 2024 at 00.00. There will be no access to the application page before that date.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

At the time of application, the following documents must be uploaded:

- Transcript of Records from e-Devlet (Mandatory)
- Scanned version of Turkish ID or residence permit (Mandatory)
- TOEFL/YDS/YÖKDİL/e-YDS/e-YÖKDİL Exam Result (it is mandatory only for those who will not take the IHU Erasmus English Exam and wants to submit other scores)
- Document proving disadvantagement mentioned in the list of criteria (if available)
- Petition of permission for the 4th semester MA and PhD students (if available)
- * Any application with wrong documents or misleading statements will be deemed invalid.
- * Transcript of Records without a date of issue will be deemed invalid.
- * All application documents must be uploaded completely to the TURNA PORTAL. Submissions that are not made within the dates presented in the application calendar will not be accepted.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Student selections are made according to the selection criteria specified in the Erasmus+ Implementation Handbook (Ulusal Ajans El Kitabı). The evaluation criteria and weighted scores to be used in evaluating the mobility applications are given below:

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ATTENTION: This call grants 1 student to the University of Sarajevo (UNSA) and 1 student to the University of Vlora "Ismail Qemali" only. Applicants who wish to participate in the mobility in KIMEP University will be considered **non-grant**. Only the departments specified in the list are eligible to apply for this KA-171 Study Mobility (International Credit Mobility) call.

Other criteria mentioned in the table below are also taken into account in the evaluation. Based on these situations, reductions and increases are made on the total score:

Students with their first degree relatives or themselves receiving AFAD aid for disaster victims 1st degree relatives mean: mother, father, child, spouse **	+10 points
Benefit from the KA171 program before (with or without grant)	-10 points
Participating in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points
Failure to participate in the mobility without giving a timely waiver notice despite being selected for the mobility	-10 points
Applying to two mobility types of KA171 at the same time (reduction is applied to the student's preferred mobility type)	-10 points
For students selected for mobility: Not participating in meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution on mobility without an excuse (applicable if the student applies for Erasmus again)	-5 points
Not taking the language exam without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)	-5 points

- * The Disability Health Board report specified in the "Regulation on Disability Assessment for Adults" published in the Official Gazette dated February 20, 2019, No. 30692 must be uploaded to TURNAPORTAL.
- ** This additional point is applied only once. If selected, it will not apply to the student's subsequent applications. However, if the student is not selected, the





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additional points will continue to be applied to their future applications.

ARE GRANTS PROVIDED?

Grants are given to students to ensure that some of their expenses are covered during their activity period abroad. The table of grant amount and travel grant to be given to students are given below:

GRANT SUPPORT FOR TRAVEL EXPENSES

A travel grant will be given to students who have the right to receive a grant, depending on the distance between Ibn Haldun University and the partner institution. The distance will be calculated using distance calculator:

^{*} Green travel means using low carbon emission transportation. This includes buses, trains, and car sharing. To qualify for green travel support, you need to use green transportation for both the outgoing and return trips, and more than half of your total journey must be done with green vehicles.

OPPORTUNITIES AND ADDITIONAL GRANT SUPPORT FOR DISABLED AND DISADVANTAGED PARTICIPANTS

Disadvantaged participants will be able to receive an additional grant of 250 € per month in addition to the grant they receive in student mobility whose activity period lasts between 2-12 months. In order for the grant in question to be awarded, the disadvantaged participant is defined as an individual with limited economic and social opportunities and who fits into the following sub-categories:

- Subject to Law No. 2828 (Those who have a protection, care or shelter decision by the Ministry of Family and Social Services (Aile ve Sosyal Politikalar Bakanlığı) pursuant to Law No. 2828)
- Students for whom protection, care or accommodation decision has been taken within the scope of Child Protection Law No. 5395
- Those who receive an orphan/death pension
- Spouse and children of martyrs/veterans
- Persons who are granted financial support for themselves or their families (a document proving that the student received financial support from municipalities, public institutions and organizations such as ministries, Sosyal Yardımlaşma ve Dayanışma Vakıfları, Vakıflar Genel Müdürlüğü, Kızılay, AFAD are needed as proof during the Erasmus application)
- Disabled students
- Individuals whose parents or guardians receive disability or social assistance pensions, under the Law No. 2022, dated 01.07.1976 (65 Yaşını Doldurmuş Muhtaç, Güçsüz Ve Kimsesiz Türk Vatandaşları İle Engelli Ve Muhtaç Türk Vatandaşlarına Aylık Bağlanması Hakkında Kanun)
- Students with their first degree relatives or themselves receiving AFAD aid for disaster victims.





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MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED BY CANDIDATES CONSIDERING PARTICIPATION IN MOBILITY?

- 1. Double major students can only apply for the Erasmus Study Mobility with just one of their majors in the same application period.
- 2. Double major students who will apply for mobility must have taken at least 25 ECTS in their second major.
- 3. The higher education institution cuts the grant in the following cases:
- If a student does not complete the participant survey (EU Survey), 20% of the total grant cannot be given, unless technical reasons were the cause.
- In order for the grant to be paid in full, at least 2/3 of the total ECTS received in the relevant mobility must be successfully completed with a passing grade. Students who do not successfully complete at least 20 ECTS (or 2/3 of the total credits) out of the 30 ECTS must pay back the 80% received in the beginning of the mobility and are not eligible to receive the remaining 20% of the grant. Full academic recognition is given to successful credits in the program followed.
- The minimum duration of activity is a minimum of 2 months for each student. Those who leave the program before this period is completed will not be able to receive a grant unless there is **force majeure with official documents**. For students who have completed a minimum of 2 months of activity and return in less than the time specified in the invitation letter, the amount to be deducted is determined based on the number of activity days not performed.
- If the documents proving participation in the mobility (certificate of participation or the post-return transcript (ToR) that can replace it) are not submitted, the mobility will be deemed invalid and the student will not be paid a grant; the previously paid grant will be reclaimed from the student.
- 4. Please carefully review the academic calendar of the institution you prefer and make sure that it is compatible with the IHU academic calendar.
- 5. It is obligatory to take 30 ECTS courses in a semester. For this reason, you should check the web page of the relevant university (it can be under the headings of ECTS Course Catalog, ECTS Info Pack, etc.) and make your choices by consulting your Erasmus Department/Program Coordinator.





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- 6. Students who wish can waive grant support.
- 7. Non-grant students are also subject to a general evaluation together with other applicants and go through the same process as grant students. Students who would like to participate in Erasmus+ Study Mobility by their own means, need to submit a petition of participating non-grant. The petition should be submitted after the announcement of results and **before the nomination deadline** indicated in the calendar above.
- 8. Non-grant students can extend their mobility to be 12 months, but granted students cannot participate in KA171 International Credit Mobility for more than one semester.
- 9. In cases not specified in the announcement, the rules in the Erasmus+ Implementation Handbook (2023 KA-171 Ulusal Ajans Uygulama El Kitabı) will apply.
- 10. Further details that will be encountered before, during and after the mobility for the students who are eligible for Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility will be explained in the Erasmus+ Orientation where participation is compulsory (check the calendar above).
