A- WHAT IS BIP?

Blended Intensive Program Mobility is a type of mobility that is part face-to-face and part online. After the mobility, 3 ECTS course credits are processed on the student's transcript. The student is obliged to attend both face-to-face and online classes, and must submit the requested assignment or projects. It is of course planning.

B- WHO CAN APPLY?

Students enrolled and currently active in the following programs can apply:

- BA in Economics
- BA in Management

- MA in Economics
- MSc in Financial Economics
- MA in Islamic Economics and Finance
- MA in Management (both Turkish and English departments)
- MSc in Air Transport Management
- MA in Big Data and Business Analytics

C- WHO CANNOT APPLY?

1. Students enrolled in programs listed above but graduating before 30 July 2026 cannot apply, as the participant of BIP mobility will have a 3 ECTS course in his/her transcript.
2. The following students cannot apply:
 - Students enrolled in other programs not indicated above
 - Students who are in Language Preparatory year
 - Students who are in their first semester of undergraduate/graduate program in Ibn Haldun University (IHU) and has no GPA during the application period from the courses registered in IHU
 - Students who came with a transfer from another institution and are in the first semester of their registration in IHU (i.e. a transfer student who has not yet received a GPA from courses taken in IHU during the application period)

D- WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION CRITERIA?

1. Academic GPA of at least 2.50/4.00 for undergraduate students, and at least 3.00/4.00 for graduate students (masters and PhD).
 - Your transcript has to be downloaded from e-devlet (www.turkiye.gov.tr). Please upload **a transcript issued with dates after the start of application**, i.e. 13 February 2026. Please upload ALL PAGES of your transcript in a single PDF file.
2. A minimum score of TOEFL (84/120), YDS/e-YDS (70/100), YÖKDİL/e-YÖKDİL (70/100) or PTE Academic (71/90) exam results should be obtained. The relevant exam results are **valid for two years** from the date of receipt.
 - Students who do not have a valid score for English level, must participate in the IHU English exam on 3rd of March 2026. IHU Erasmus English Exam is valid only for the current mobility application call. The result of this exam cannot be used for the upcoming mobility calls.
 - Only one exam result will be considered. If you mark two options during the application, your application will be considered **invalid**.
 - The IHU Versant exam (done when the student is applying to IHU for his program or when ending Prep-School) is not a valid exam in Erasmus+ applications.

E- WHERE DO I APPLY?

Applications must be made through the TURNA PORTAL system. Application link; <https://turnaportal.gov.tr/>

F- WHAT DOCUMENTS/FORMS ARE NEEDED FOR SUBMISSION?

At the time of application, the following documents must be uploaded.

- Scanned version of Turkish ID or residence permit (**Mandatory**)
- Transcript of Records (**Mandatory**)
- TOEFL/YDS/YÖKDİL/e-YDS/e-YÖKDİL/PTE-Academic Exam Result (it is mandatory only for those who will not take the IHU Erasmus English Exam)
- Document proving disadvantage mentioned in the list of criteria (if available)

G- HOW IS THE EVALUATION MADE?

Student selections are made according to the selection criteria specified in the Erasmus+ Implementation Handbook. The selection is made according to the ranking results of the students who have the highest score within the quota for each faculty/department.*

After the score ranking, placements are made by considering the institution preference order of the students with high scores. The evaluation criteria and weighted scores to be used in evaluating the mobility applications are given below:

Criterion	Weighted score
<i>Academic achievement level</i>	<i>50% (out of a total of 100 points)</i>
<i>Language level</i>	<i>50% (out of a total of 100 points)</i>

* The total quota is **3 students**:

- Only one student from the same department can receive a grant for the BIP Mobility (for example, only one student in the Economics Department can have a grant for BIP Mobility).
- The final decision on the quotas will be taken by the Erasmus and International Programs Admission Committee after the end of applications, in parallel with the project budget and quotas of the receiving institution.

Other criteria mentioned in the table below are also taken into account in the evaluation. Based on these situations, reductions and increases are made on the total score:

<i>Benefit from the KA131 program before (with or without a grant) ***</i>	<i>-10 points</i>
<i>Participating mobility in a country with citizenship</i>	<i>-10 points</i>
<i>Submitting an internship acceptance letter at the time of application</i>	<i>+10 points</i>
<i>Failure to participate in the mobility without giving a timely waiver notice despite being selected for the mobility</i>	<i>-10 points</i>
<i>Applying to two mobility types at the same time (reduction is applied to the student's preferred mobility type)</i>	<i>-10 points</i>
<i>For students selected for mobility: Not participating in meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution on mobility without an excuse (applicable if the student applies for Erasmus again)</i>	<i>-5 points</i>
<i>Not taking the language exam without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)</i>	<i>-5 points</i>

* The Disability Health Board report specified in the "Regulation on Disability Assessment for Adults" published in the Official Gazette dated February 20, 2019, No. 30692 must be uploaded to TURNA PORTAL.

** This additional point is applied only once. If selected, it will not apply to the student's subsequent applications. However, if the student is not selected, the additional points will continue to be applied to their future applications. If the student resides in the earthquake region, he/she has to upload "Tarihçeli Yerleşim Yeri Belgesi" from e-devlet. If the first degree relative of the student is an earthquake victim, the student has to prove his/her relative's residency ("Tarihçeli Yerleşim Yeri Belgesi" of the student's relative from e-devlet) and also their degree of relationship ("Tam Aile Kayıt Örneği from e-devlet). As a second option, the student can upload a document from AFAD (wet-signed or retrieved from e-devlet) for proving the aid of his relative per his victimness. In both cases, documents must be uploaded to the TURNA PORTAL before the end of application.

*** BIP, short-term doctoral mobility, and short-term blended mobility participations are not considered within this scope.

Considering all the criteria, if the total score calculated is equal, priority is given to the student with a high academic success grade. And if the academic success grade is equal as well, then the younger student is given priority.

IMPORTANT: All students will be in the status of candidates, until the final evaluation is done by the receiving institution.

H- ARE THERE OPPORTUNITIES AND ADDITIONAL GRANT SUPPORT FOR DISABLED AND DISADVANTAGED PARTICIPANTS?

Disadvantaged participants will be able to receive an additional grant of 100€ in addition to the grant they receive in BIP mobility whose physical activity period lasts between 5-14 days. Additional grant is not confirmed until the decision is made based on the budget of the project.

In order for the grant in question to be awarded, the disadvantaged participant is defined as an individual with limited economic and social opportunities and who fits into the following sub-categories:

- Subject to Law No. 2828 (Those who have a protection, care or shelter decision by the Ministry of Family and Social Services pursuant to Law No. 2828)
- Students for whom protection, care or accommodation decision has been taken within the scope of Child Protection Law No. 5395
- Those who receive an orphan's pension
- Children of Martyrs / Veterans
- Persons who are granted financial support for themselves or their families (proof required during the application phase by obtaining a document that indicates the student received financial support from municipalities, public institutions, and organizations such as ministries, Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundations (Sosyal Yardımlaşma ve Dayanışma Vakıfları), Directorate General of Foundations (Vakıflar Genel Müdürlüğü), Kızılay, AFAD)
- Disabled students
- Individuals whose parents or guardians receive disability or social assistance pensions, under the Law No. 2022, dated 01.07.1976 (65 Yaşını Doldurmuş Muhtaç, Güçsüz Ve Kimsesiz Türk Vatandaşları İle Engelli Ve Muhtaç Türk Vatandaşlarına Aylık Bağlanması Hakkında Kanun)
- Students with their first-degree relatives or themselves receiving AFAD aid for disaster victims.

After winning the chance to receive a grant, the student with the above-mentioned criteria might receive an extra grant for being in the disadvantaged group.

I- WHAT ARE THE MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED BY CANDIDATES CONSIDERING PARTICIPATION IN MOBILITY?

Physical activity dates: 5 days in the period of 8 – 12 June 2026

Venue: Albena resort (approx. 30 km north of Varna)

Virtual activity dates: 8 contact hours delivered in the period of 29 June – 3 July 2026

It is mandatory for the participant to attend both physical and virtual components of the BIP mobility.

Grant details: 79 EUR per day x 7 days (5 days on the spot + 2 days for travel) = 553 EUR
