4-Year Undergraduate Program:
Maximum Study Duration (7 Years)



**End of Maximum
Duration**

Students with Failed Courses

Students Who Passed All Courses



**Initial Right for
Failed Courses**

2 additional exam rights for
all registered and failed
courses (including repeat
courses)



**Without Taking Additional Exams:
Students with Up to 5 Failed Courses**

Right to an Additional 4 Semesters



**After Additional Exams:
Students Whose Failed Courses Decrease to 5**

Right to an Additional 3 Semesters



**After Additional Exams:
Students Whose Failed Courses Decrease to 1**

Unlimited Exam Right
(Without Student Status Benefits)



**GPA Insufficiency
Case**

Unlimited exam right for those
who pass all courses but cannot
graduate due to insufficient GPA



**Unlimited Exam Right and
Attendance Requirement**

Attendance is required for practical,
applied, and previously uncompleted
courses.



Important Rule: Student Rights

Student rights cannot be utilized in
cases where additional exam rights and
extra time are granted.



**Important Rule: Fees and Loss of
Rights**

Those with unlimited exam attempts pay a fee
per ECTS credit. Students who do not take exams
for a total of 3 academic years lose their right to take
the exams.
