IBN HALDUN UNIVERSITY MULTILINGUALISM POLICY RULES FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

- 1. Some proficiency levels in English, Turkish, and Arabic (or in another language except for Arabic) are required for graduation in all the programs except those stated below. Students fulfill this requirement by attending a language preparation program before starting their graduate programs or passing the language courses they take with their graduate courses. In addition, if the students certify their proficiency in these languages by the results of language exams accepted by the University, they also fulfill this requirement. The Head of the Department decides the level of language proficiency.
- **2.** Multilingualism is optional for all non-thesis programs and only thesis programs in Turkish if the program does not require it.
- **3.** Multilingualism is not required as a graduation requirement for graduate programs (with/without a thesis) held through an agreement with an institution.
- **4.** Upon the relevant Graduate School's request and the Rectorate's approval, non-multilingual programs or programs may be opened.
- 5. Heads of Departments require that in master's and/or Ph.D. programs where multilingualism is a graduation condition, English and Turkish are compulsory, Arabic as a third language or a language other than Arabic is optional, which is determined by the student's thesis work and recommended by the advisor.
- **6.** A student is given a two-semester preparatory program in one language at most. The maximum duration of language preparation programs is two years.
- 7. English proficiency is at least B1 level as a graduation requirement for programs subject to multilingualism.
- **8.** Students whose native language is not Turkish must be able to use Turkish at a minimum A2 level by graduation in programs where the medium of instruction is English.
- **9.** In the language(s) determined as Arabic or a third language other than Arabic, the level required for graduation is at least A2.
- **10.** The Administrative Board's proposal and the Senate's approval determine whether the language courses are with or without the credit.
- **11.** These rules only apply to students who come to our university through transfer before the 2019-2020 academic year, Fall semester.
- 12. Depending on the program, the student enrolled certifies their proficiency in the languages listed in the table below and fulfills their third language requirement for Arabic or a language other than Arabic within the scope of these principles. In case of requests from students for languages not included in the table, the Graduate School Administrative Board evaluates this request with the opinion of the student's thesis advisor and the recommendation of the Department Head.

- 13.4. Those who have studied in secondary or higher education institutions in the Republic of Turkey or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, where the Turkish language is spoken as the native language, and have completed their secondary education or bachelor's degree in these institutions and programs that provide education in Turkish (Dual citizenship and one of their nationalities is the Republic of Turkey or the Turkish Northern Cyprus) are exempt. Turkish citizens who do not meet the above requirements must take the exemption exam to be exempted from the Turkish obligation,

Those who have studied at secondary or higher education institutions in a country where the Arabic language is spoken as a native language, as in the table below, where the citizens of that country attend, and completed their secondary education or undergraduate education in these institutions and programs providing education in Arabic,

Those who have studied at secondary or higher education institutions in a country where the English language is spoken as a native language, as in the table below, where the citizens of that country attend, and completed their secondary education or undergraduate education in these institutions and programs providing education in English,

13.9. Those who complete their undergraduate or graduate studies at Ibn Haldun University and enroll in graduate or Ph. D. programs at Ibn Haldun University and who are successful in the languages covered by the Principles of Multilingualism during their undergraduate or graduate education with a thesis is exempt from the Principles of Multilingualism.

14. The validity period for those who have taken the language courses within the Principles of Multilingualism of the Ibn Haldun University School of Foreign Languages or passed the exemption exam for these languages is five (5) years from the date the course grade is announced, or the exam is held.
