

## IBN HALDUN UNIVERSITY HOBBY GARDENS TERMS OF USE

1. The size of each mini-garden is 18 m2, and each garden is for the exclusive use of one person.
2. The duration of use is for one academic year (from September to end of August).
3. Pre-planting weeding and post-planting maintenance tasks are the responsibility of the garden owner.
4. The following materials will be provided by the garden owner for use in the area:
  - Seedlings, seeds, and other planting needs,
  - Equipment for sowing and planting,
  - Watering hose and drip irrigation system,
  - Materials such as stakes and support structures depending on the type of seedling,
  - Materials such as pesticides and fertilizers, as needed,
  - Surrounding and protective materials to prevent damage from external factors or weather conditions.
5. There is no storage facility in the garden area, so the used materials should not be left in the area. Otherwise, no responsibility will be accepted.
6. If any materials such as pesticides or fertilizers are used in the garden, please inform the authorized personnel.
7. The hobby gardens will be periodically inspected by our university's landscaping teams. As a result of these inspections:
  - Users who fail to perform the necessary maintenance for their gardens for at least two months will have their usage rights revoked and will not be eligible to participate in the next hobby garden lottery.
  - Unused gardens due to the failure of the primary users to fulfill their maintenance responsibilities will be offered to backup users (in the order of the draw) for the remaining usage period.
  - All rights regarding the usage and transfer processes of hobby gardens are under the responsibility of the Department of Art, Culture, and Sports.
